Definitions of Management by various authors

1. Pawel Gautam: "It is difficult to give a precise definition of the term management. Different management authors have viewed management from their own angles moreover, during the evolutionary process of management different thinkers laid emphasis on different aspects."
2. Harold Koontz: "Management is the art of getting things done through others and with formally organised groups."
3. F.W. Taylor: "Management is the art of knowing what you want to do and then seeing that they do it in the best and the cheapest manner."
4. George R.Terry: "Management is a distinct process consisting of planning, organising, actuating and controlling; utilising in each both science and arts, and followed in order to accomplish pre-determined objectives."
5. Peter Drucker: "Management is a multipurpose organ that manages a business and manages managers and manages workers and work."
6. Henri Fayol: "Management is to forecast, to plan, to organise, to command, to co-ordinate and control activities of others."
7. M.P. Follett: "Management is the art of getting things done through people."
8. Mary Cushing Nile: "Good management, or scientific management, achieves a social objective with the best use of human and material energy and time, and with satisfaction for the participants and the public."
9. Joseph Massie: "Management is defined as the process by which a co-operative group directs action towards common goals."
10. Theo Haimann & William Scott: "Management is a social and technical process which utilises, resources, influences, human action and facilitates changes in order to accomplish organisational goals."
11. Traditional View Point Modern View Point
 - Art of getting things done by other
 - Process of planning, organising, staffing, directing and controlling activities of others
 - Mobilising and utilising physical and human resources for achieving organisational goal
 - Prime mover of organisation making it functional and productive
 - Process of creating conducive and proper internal environment in the organisation
 - Process of coping with changing external environment by relating strengths and weaknesses of the organisation with it.

Conclusion: Management simply means a specific process of planning, organising, staffing, directing and controlling the efforts of the people who are engaged in activities in business organisation in order to attain predetermined objective of such organisations.

The essential part of the conclusion lies within **'a specific process of'** to gain success of the rest of the conclusion. The only way to gain success in managing a body is to have a strategic plan in place. But what is strategic planning? "Strategic planning is **an organisational management activity that is used to set priorities, focus energy and resources**, strengthen operations, ensure that employees and other stakeholders are working toward common goals, establish agreement around intended outcomes/results. Strategic planning is the approach used in forming an organisation's direction (e.g., its vision, mission and priorities). On the other hand, **strategic management is the overall process of achieving that direction**, from planning to executing."

With the above in mind, the EXCO of the IJF has decided to come together for such a planning session. It will be held during the week-end of 8 to 11 April 2022 in Windhoek.

Yes, the EXCO is fully aware of the costs involved, but it is essential to have such a work session. We, as EXCO, are responsible to lead and introduce Jukskei (Jukskay) successfully into and to the world.

One of the main discussion points will be the actions to be taken and the material availability, in a written and visual format, to encourage interested countries to become **Full Members** of the IJF.

The EXCO hopes to receive enough feedback from the various countries, as requested in the President Council Circular, which must be replied to by 28 February 2022.

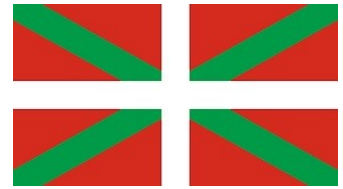
