Umpires




Tafisa


























Private Schools Sports Weekend (Namibia)

May 2022

Every year a very large sports week takes place under the guidance of Napso (Namibia Private Schools Organisation). During the week, most private schools in Namibia participate in the activities. Currently, there are about 13 private schools in the country. Usually, the activities already begin on the Wednesday and then end on the Saturday evening.

Over the years jukskei has been part of the week, and is very well represented by the schools. A secondary school and primary school division participated and this year there have been 14 teams in total.

Although jukskei was part of the activities, it was not recognised as an official school sport, but was only seen as an extracurricular activity. Namibia Junior Jukskei sent a letter to Napso earlier the year requesting the possibility that jukskei be recognised as an official school sport. The good news is that Napso had considered our request favourably and it is now officially recognised as a school sport at all private schools in Namibia.

We further asked permission to select four Napso jukskei teams namely high schools boys and girls as well as primary schools boys and girls. Napso had given permission to us and we selected four teams during this year's tournament. This gave our juniors another opportunity to be recognised for good achievements.

There are no winners named after the games, it's about participation and the gathering of schools across the country.

Two of the Napso teams will participate in the upcoming Namibia Jukskei Open Championships which will take place in Swakopmund during July 2022.
